### Meeting

#### 1. Secretary/Treasurer report

Larry Whiteside (KN4MVH)-Sec/Treasurer: Deposits \$600.39 of which \$48.00 dues, \$551 in donations, and interest of \$1.39. Expenses totaled \$140.00 of which \$90.00 to cover two day rental for Kinser Park Pavilion, \$30 for the GLPS and \$20 for a pavilion at Hardin Park.

#### 2. Old business:
