### Meeting

#### 1. Secretary/Treasurer report

#### 2. Old business:

Tower repairs (Bobby Gass -N4FV / Dennis Holt-N4DWH): Bryan (W2BRN) reported that he went up to the tower with Steel Guy (Travis) to evaluation the stairs. Stairs need some painting, welding, and railing repairs but the wood landing is in bad shape and we need to have carpenter look at those repairs. Painting and railing repairs would be about \$500 plus paint which is very expensive (about \$150 a gallon for the right stuff rust preventive paint). Metal needs to cleaned/wire brushed before painting. Roof and siding is also in bad shape and needs work, including painting.

One of the club members read about some funding sources that we might be able to secure for tower repairs. He will find the info and send to Ian and Larry.

Denny attempted to contact John at University of Memphis about getting into tower making repairs to their equipment but he never heard back from them. Bryan Smith now has fire tower keys.

Hamfest 2022 (April 16<sup>th</sup>) will be on Easter weekend. Larry Whiteside has submitted paperwork to ARRL for sponsorship but has not heard back from them. Ian is thinking that maybe we could move the Hamfest from the fairgrounds to the school in 2023 to take advantage of the class rooms, parking lots and gym for the indoor sales. More discussion to come on this.

Field Day: Stats were submitted Larry Whiteside. Plaque for BOOMCO. Bryan (W2BRN) provided receipt for \$42 for diesel fuel for the generator. Bryan will give plaque to BOOMCO owner.
