1)Larry Whiteside has proposed to SKYWarn leadership to have Greene County move from SKYWarn District 7 to SKYWarn District 6. This would move us away from the district that is using only GMRS as the sole means to communicate during weather related events and training and put us into a district that is more in line with other counties that use amateur radio as the primary means to activate during events and do training nets. Larry has had a discussion with Dale Knight of District 6 about this and Dale has no objections to this change. He will be working on the process to make the change happen.

2)Confirm that the AJARC club members would allow the use of the AJARC repeaters for emergency SKYWarn net activations if we held a county wide only SKYWarn net and related training nets.
